Japan is going through a very difficult time right now with the devastating Earthquakes and Tsunami that destroyed many towns and cities in north eastern parts of Japan and we certainly offer the deepest condolences to those who are severely affected by the catastrophe and those who lost the lives of their loved ones.

However, Kuroda Precision Industries Ltd., including the facilities at headquarters, the plants located in Chiba and Nagano prefectures and other facilities are not affected so much, except for the sales office in Sendai area, which is one of the hard hit areas by the Tsunami. Plus, most importantly, we did not have any casualties within our company. Therefore, we were able to resume on Monday this week regular businesses and operations. But there may be some delays in transportation for the products to your destinations as some of the main roads are damaged by the series of quakes or packed with traffic. Also we have scheduled blackout commenced as of March 14, 2011 due to the power shortage in certain region of Japan only for a short period of time, that is one month or so. The areas affected by the blackouts are where head office and the factories in Chiba prefecture are located. This may cause some delay as well but we analyze that this will not cause huge issues in production and it should be minimal.
